Regularly wash your hands with soap

 If you sneeze or cough, use a tissue or the crook of your arm.
Put tissues in the bin straight away

Only one person in the toilet at a time

 If you feel ill then tell someone straight away

 Don't go in other classes unless told to.

Being Covid Safe in School

- Wash your hands for 20 seconds with soap and water when you enter or leave the room
- Wash your hands if you've used something that is shared
- Outside the classroom keep your distance from adults and children in other classes
- You can't walk around the school or go in other areas without an adult
- Bring as few things to school as possible
- If you sneeze or cough, use a tissue or the crook of your arm. Put tissues in the bin straight away
- Don't share resources unless asked to
- Only one person in the toilet at a time
- First aid is done in the classroom
- If you feel like you have a bad cough or temperature then tell someone straight away
